Challenge Week 2018 – Trip to Spain

I would like to take this opportunity to update you on the progress of the trip and inform you of the parents' meeting that will be taking place in the Summer Term.

The final cost of the trip will be £525.00 per student. To keep the costs down, the company have organised for us to fly from Exeter airport and return to Bournemouth airport. Finer details of departure and arrival times will be provided at the parents' meeting. To remind you, the cost includes; coach, flights and train travel, a two-course meal at a restaurant, a cable car ride, a full-day excursion to Aqualand, a one-hour catamaran cruise in Málaga Bay, evening trips to the shopping Centre and town centre, afternoons at the beach and full-board accommodation in a 3* hotel. Students will be travelling with hand luggage only, however all staff members will have hold luggage which will be used to store students' essential larger liquid items such as the all-important sun cream!

By the Easter holidays (Thursday 29th March 2018) I will need the following passport information and dietary requirements. Your child can either bring their passport into school to be photocopied at reception or you can email myself either a scanned copy or the following details:

- Nationality
- Dietary Requirements

All students will need an EHIC card to ensure free medical care in the case of any emergencies. These are free and can be ordered online here: www.ehic.org.uk. They are usually quick to arrive (within 3 weeks) but do expire after five years in case you have one already.
