Sunday 1st July - Friday 6th July 2018

Full Board accommodation

During this action-packed trip you will explore the sights of Málaga on foot and via a catamaran cruise of the bay. You will have the opportunity to visit the picturesque Mount Calamorro via cable car before enjoying some time at the beach or hotel pool. One evening you will enjoy a delicious two course meal with paella at a highly recommended local restaurant followed by an authentic flamenco show. Towards the end of the week you will spend the day at Aqualandia, which hosts Europe's tallest Kamikaze water slide.

Enjoy a trip to the French capital. Your trip will include a full day of site seeing around Paris - Grande Arche, Champs Elysées, Arc de Triomphe, Seine river cruise, Montparnasse Tower or Eiffel Tower, Pei's Pyramid at the Louvre, Palais Royal and Les Invalides. As well as a full day at the amazing Disneyland Paris, which will include entrance to the two different parks and an evening meal in the park. Group passport and insurance included.

Greece Sports Tour (Netball & Football)

Located one hour outside Athens, Loutraki Sportcamp allows teams to train and dine together on-site. Highly recommended for its on-site leisure activities and sporting possibilities, it's perfect for touring teams. Use of onsite facilities including football pitches and netball courts for daily training sessions, playing in fixtures against 2 local netball or football teams. Athens day trip including visits to the Panathenaic Stadium, Acropolis and Athens Mall, Heraion Lake Visit including lunch at Ypanema Restaurant and water sports to include stand up paddle boarding, kayaking and snorkelling (subject to approval), and finally a day trip to Loutraki town and beach.
