KS3 Assessment Criteria

Platinum blond 9 – Through and detailed Use of geographical terms

Accurate spelling and punctuation excellent

Gold 7-8 – Good work showing sound understanding and correct use of geographical terms. Some aspect of the content may be missing or lacking in sufficient detail and explanation. A few spelling punctuation and grammar errors.

Silver 4-6 – Some understanding of the work shown, with some use of geographical terms. The task has not been completed thoroughly and content may be brief with inaccuracies and spelling, punctuation and grammar. There is lack of care with presentation.

Bronze 1-3 –Work is below the required standard – a large content is missing and a lack of understanding. Presentation, spelling and punctuation are poor. Lack of time and effort has been put into the task. Barely attempted tasks.

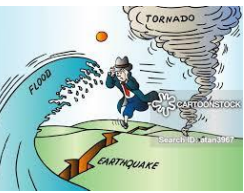
