- Any other ideas you have....



# Food enrichment activity 1 - Crumble

## Recipe: Apple Crumble

**Equipment:** dish, small bowl, sharp knife, tsp, fork, peeler

1. Preheat the oven to 190C.
2. Place 150g flour and 90g sugar in a large bowl and mix well.
3. Add 100g butter and rub into the flour mixture. Keep rubbing until the mixture resembles breadcrumbs.
4. On a chopping board peel and chop 2 apples into a large dice.
5. Place the fruit in your dish and sprinkle over the extra 25g sugar, 2tsp flour and ½tsp cinnamon.
6. Add the optional sultanas.
7. Stir the fruit mixture.
8. Sprinkle the crumble mixture on top. And press down slightly with a fork.
9. Bake in the oven for 30 minutes until the crumble is browned and the fruit mixture bubbling.

### Ingredients:

- 150g plain flour
- 90g brown sugar [topping]
- 100g butter/margarine
- 250g or 2 large apples
- 25g brown sugar [filling]
- 2tsp plain flour
- ½ tsp mixed spice





Pick a single small object. **Make 15 abstract photographs** of that object investigating it from different angles.

# Performing Arts Enrichment Activity


**Digital Theatre Plus** – Is the online platform we use to watch live theatre. To get onto this you need to use your **Brannel email & password**.

**On the website, you have access to a wide variety of plays and musicals. As well as information on design routes in Theatre, Theatre Companies, Practitioners and various scripts.**

One production to consider watching is Macbeth, as this is the play we are studying this term in Drama.

When logged in, type in the search bar *'Macbeth'* you will come *'Title - Macbeth'* and will need to watch this version of the play:



When watching the production, consider the following questions:

- Who wrote Macbeth?
- What do the Witches say to Macbeth?
- What does Macbeth need to do to become King?
- Describe Lady Macbeth using 3 *adjectives*?
- What does it mean when Macbeth see's the dagger before him?
- What does guilt mean? Why is guilt relevant in the play?
- How would you rate what they have seen so far out of 5 Stars (5 being the top score), you must justify why.
- How would you describe one characters costume design?
- How is set used throughout the play?

How does the music throughout the performance create an atmosphere and setting?

What instruments can you hear?
