<b>English</b>	Final Exam Dates: Literature Paper 1: 13 May 2024 Literature Paper 2: 20 May 2024 Language Paper 1 exam: 23 May 2024 Language Paper 2 exam: 06 June 2024
<b>Maths</b>	In the final push now for your Maths GCSEs. Friday staples challenges to help you prepare for the Maths GCSEs. Keep using Sparx to help you with independent revision.
<b>Science</b>	All Year 11 will be revising and completing their GCSE exams in the summer term. All Year 11 have six Science exams.
<b>History</b>	Year 11's summer term allows students to develop their skills of analysis, evaluation and have independent and teacher led revision time.
<b>Geography</b>	Year 11 will be focussing on their Pre-release booklet that forms part of their Paper 3 exams. Revision will be the focus as the course comes to an end and they begin preparing for their Paper 1 (17th May) Paper 2 (5th June) & Paper 3 (14th June) GCSE examinations.
<b>French / Spanish</b>	GCSE exams.
<b>Computer Science</b>	Looking at the skills you will need to excel in your up coming exams.
<b>Art</b>	Getting you ready for you upcoming exams.
<b>Drama</b>	This term students will be working towards their component 3 written exam including how to write a live theatre review and exam structure.
<b>Music</b>	This term year 11 will be completing their component 3 controlled assessment "Responding to a Music Brief".
<b>Food Technology</b>	Preparing you for your upcoming exams and making sure everything is in place to achieve your best possible results.
