Year 11 English Language	Autumn Term	Students will spend the start of Year 11 recapping and revising GCSE English Language Paper 1 , ahead of their mock exam in November.	In revisiting Language Paper 1, students identify their personal strengths and weaknesses and seek to improve their own unique exam performance through routine exam practice and reflection .	Students' Year 11 revision in preparation for securing their GCSE success , requires students to grow their independence, resilience and ability to self-reflect , preparing them for further study and later life.
Year 11 English Literature	Autumn Term	Alongside their English Language exam practice, students will finalise their literature study in the reading of their remaining Literature text – J.B. Priestley's 1945 play, ' An Inspector Calls '. After their reading of the play, students close their course of study with a focus on Unseen Poetry – the third and final component of their GCSE English Literature Paper 2 exam .	In their study of a wide selection of unseen poems, students enrich their knowledge of poetic techniques whilst also building their resilience and confidence when analysing previously unseen texts independently. By finishing their course of study in the Autumn term of Year 11, students carry the advantage of a solid 6-month preparation period for their GCSE exams .	
Year 11 English Language	Spring and Summer Term	After completing their English Language Paper 1 mock exam and reflecting on their performance, students will use their reflection to guide their revision of English Language Paper 2 in the Spring Term ahead of their Paper 2 mock	In reflecting on their Paper 2 performance and through revisiting Language Paper 1 , students identify their personal strengths and weaknesses and seek to improve their own unique exam performance through routine exam practice and reflection .
