Enrichment & Student Experience

At Brannel School, we are committed to the holistic development of every learner. We believe that education extends far beyond the classroom and that personal development and the enrichment of cultural capital are vital in preparing students to become well-rounded, confident, and aspirational young people. Our strategy centres on creating rich, varied, and inclusive experiences that develop character, resilience, and ambition, while also cultivating an appreciation of cultural diversity and opportunity.

The creative arts and physical and health education are a cornerstone of our personal development programme. Our curriculum ensures all students have access to high-quality experiences in music, drama, art, design and physical education. Students can regularly participate in school productions, exhibitions, and performances, fixtures and visits further afield developing not only their creative and physical skills but also self-confidence, collaboration, and discipline. We actively engage with local artists and cultural institutions and sports clubs to promote heritage, identity, and pride in the region's creative legacy and physical literacy. We host inter-house competitions and represent the region in county and national events, promoting a sense of community and achievement.

We believe that meaningful experiences beyond the classroom are crucial to widening students' horizons and enhancing their cultural capital. Our programme of trips and visits is designed to expose students to a breadth of experiences, including theatre productions, art galleries, museums, and historical sites. We make purposeful connections to the curriculum, ensuring students can contextualise their learning. International trips, such as cultural tours, also play a key role in developing global awareness, empathy, and independence.

An effective and embedded careers education programme underpins our personal development vision. From Year 7 onwards, learners engage with a structured programme that includes encounters with employers, workplace visits, and career-focused events. We work closely with local businesses, apprenticeship providers, FE and HE institutions to give students real insight into future pathways. Personal guidance interviews, skills workshops, and enterprise projects enable students to make informed, aspirational choices that align with their interests and strengths.

Our approach reflects both the unique context of Cornwall and our belief in the transformative power of education to change lives and communities for the better.
